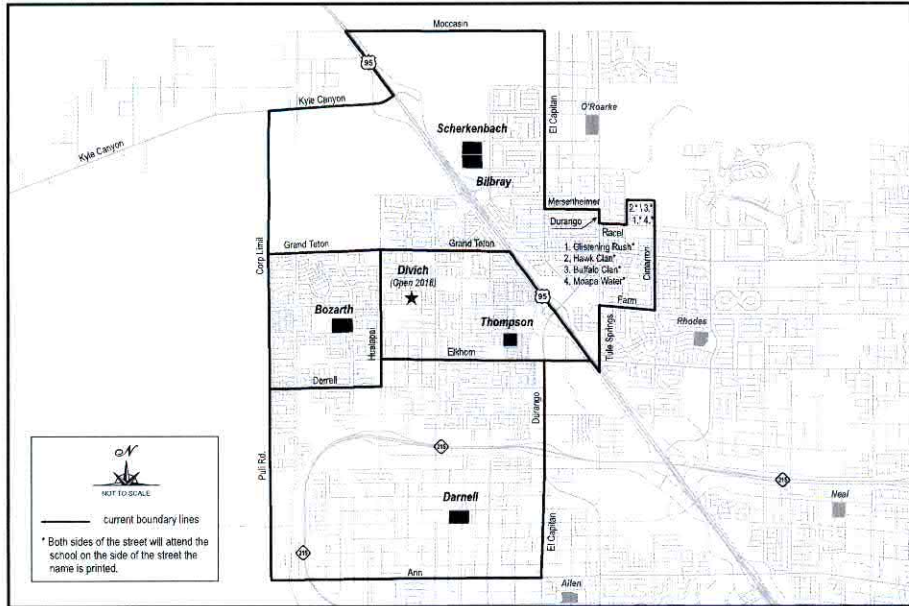

The Clark County School District's Board of School Trustees understands attendance boundary changes can be difficult for families and communities. To ensure their concerns are heard, the Board established the Attendance Zone Advisory Commission (AZAC). The members of AZAC are volunteers, parents, and concerned citizens appointed by the Board of School Trustees and the Superintendent of Schools to represent their individual districts. AZAC members review attendance boundaries each year and recommend changes to the Board of School Trustees.

Your input is a valuable part of this process. At public input meetings, proposals are presented which AZAC is considering for attendance boundaries in your area. They, along with school district staff, will be on hand to hear and consider your comments and suggestions. AZAC then formulates a final attendance boundary recommendation which will be forwarded to the Board of School Trustees for their approval on February 21, 2018 at 5:30 pm. This recommendation could be any variation of the proposals presented in this flyer, including no change to the current boundary.

La Mesa Directiva del Distrito Escolar del Condado de Clark comprende que los cambios de los límites de zona escolar pueden causar inconvenientes para las familias y las comunidades. Para asegurar que las preocupaciones de la comunidad se escuchan, la Mesa Directiva estableció una Comisión de Asesoramiento de Zona de Asistencia Escolar (AZAC). Los miembros de AZAC son voluntarios, padres de familia y ciudadanos interesados en el bienestar del alumno. Los miembros de AZAC son elegidos por la Mesa Directiva y el Superintendente del distrito escolar para representar sus respectivos distritos. Los miembros de AZAC repasan los límites de zona escolar cada año y recomiendan los cambios a la Mesa Directiva.

Su opinión es una parte valiosa en este proceso. En las reuniones públicas, los miembros de AZAC presentan las propuestas de los límites de zona que son consideradas en su área. Los miembros de AZAC y el personal del distrito escolar estarán allí listos para oír y considerar sus comentarios y sugerencias. Después los miembros de AZAC definen y finalizan las recomendaciones y las remiten a la Mesa Directiva para su aprobación el 21 de febrero, 2018 a las 5:30 pm. Esta recomendación puede variar en las propuestas presentadas en este folleto, sin incluir ningún cambio en los límites de zona actual. 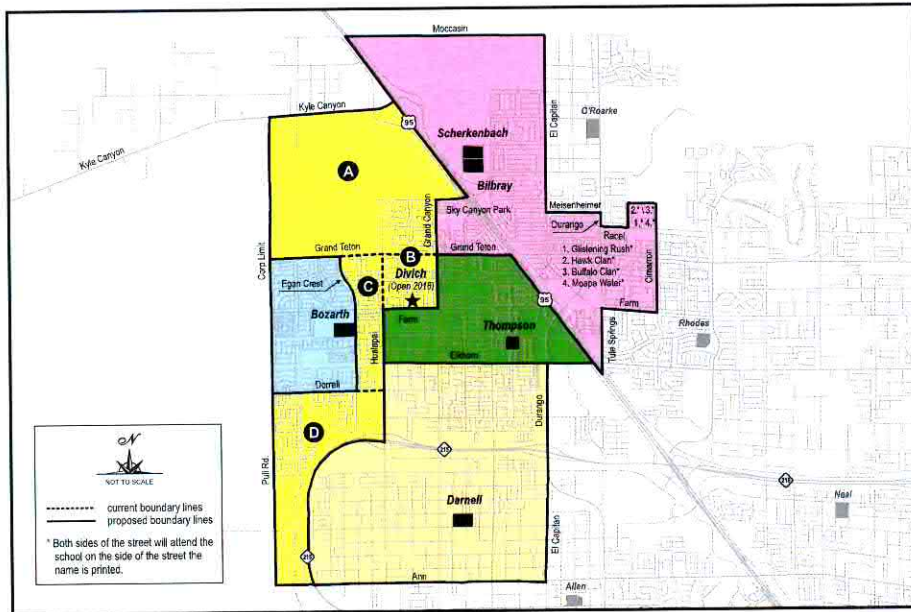

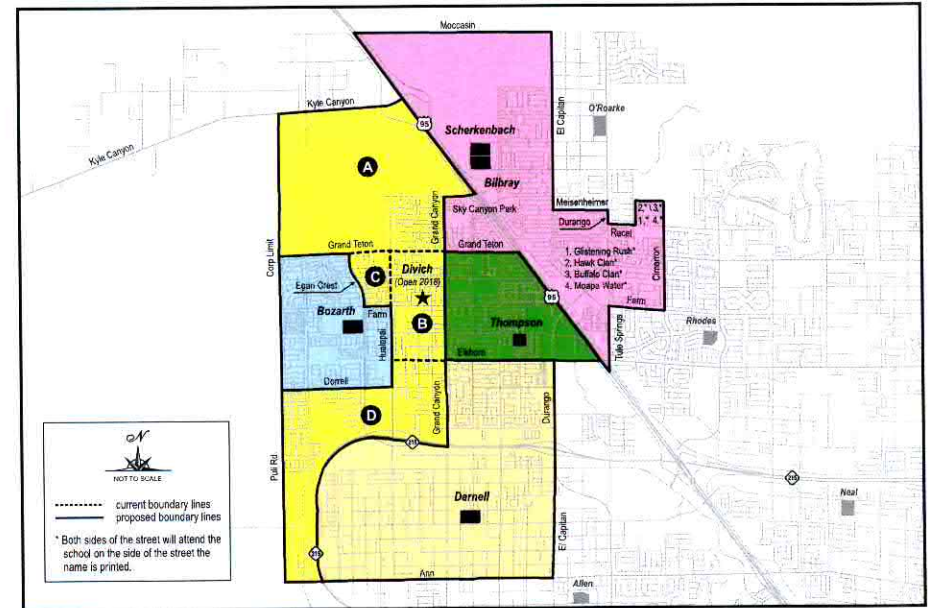
Proposal 1 Elementary School Attendance Boundaries for 2018-2019 School Year
